

Our Aims

The project's goal is to support teachers in VET to develop and adapt their training materials, focusing on their digital competencies, which are still not adequate.

Moreover, INTRAVET addresses 2 field specific priorities:

- 1. Increasing attractiveness of VET.
- 2. Contributing to innovation in Vocational and Professional training.



Activities

- 1. Map the ecosystem of VET training digitalisation to extrapolate VET organizations' needs and develop a digitalization strategy
- 2. Develop and maintain the INTRAVET OER Platform to provide visibility to project activities and promote the adoption and use of the INTRAVET tools and resources in their multilingual versions
- 3. Develop and deliver innovative training specifically tailored and targeted to VET professionals
- Validate in real operational environments the INTRAVET tools and training involving at least 120 VET professionals and 200 VET students
- 5. Promote the adoption and replication of INTRAVET by mainstreaming its use across EU
