## Consortium reunited in Bucharest for the closing meeting of INTRAVET Project

On September 27<sup>th</sup>, 2023, the consortium reunited for the final transnational meeting of INTRAVET (Innovative Training for VET Digital Readiness), a project co-funded by the Erasmus+ Programme of the European Commission. This project brought together 6 partners from 4 European countries (Belgium, Italy, Poland, Romania), active in the field of VET (associations, VET providers, companies). The meeting was hosted by the lead partner ADDE and took place in Bucharest, Romania, at the headquarters of "Virgil Madgearu" Economic College, an important public VET provider and one of the local associated partners of the project.

We were all very happy to meet again and work towards the last steps and adjustments necessary for the conclusion INTRAVET, to ensure maximum value, impact and sustainability.

The focus of INTRAVET project was to support teachers of technical disciplines to develop and adapt their training materials, focusing on their digital competences, which are still not adequate and to develop innovative training content and hands-on tools to support VET providers build their capacity to respond to digitalization related challenges, by improving their competences related to strategic digital development.

INTRAVET produced 2 main project results:

- 1. VET Digital Readiness Toolkit
- 2. Digital Competence Training for VET Teachers & Trainers

INTRAVET results are tailored to the specific needs of selected **target groups:** 

- 1. VET managers aiming to develop their competences in strategic development and ability to support staff and learners through digitalization
- 2. VET teachers/trainers/instructors who need to improve their ability to deliver high quality classes in online/digital format
- 3. VET providers/schools aiming to improve their capacity to offer better trainings by implementing digitalization
- 4. VET students, to develop their self-directed learning and digital skills



The INTRAVET Project has started on the 1<sup>st</sup> of January 2022 and its end is on 31<sup>st</sup> December 2023.

All the outputs and materials of INTRAVET can be accessed directly via <u>intravet.eu</u> website, have OER status, and they are available in English, Italian, Polish and Romanian. The website and the two results platforms will remain active for a period of at least 3 years after the finalisation of the project.
